## **Introduction:**

The following list of athletes and staff who have comprised the New Brunswick provincial teams since the inception of the Jeux du Canada / Canada Games in 1969 and the Royal Canadian Legion Age-Class Teams in 1977 is a small attempt to record a part of the history of our sport in this province.

This listing is built on a previous effort started in 1993 and then left to rest, in part resulting from a lack of understanding as to where to look for further information. With the coming of the 1997 Canada Summer Games in Brandon, Manitoba, the writer's interest was again sparked and a great deal of effort was spent in looking for the original work (typed on two pages).

This list was expanded to include the team representing N.B. at the Eastern Canadian Espoir Championships in 2002.

With the gracious assistance of Graham Blake at the Fredericton Public Library (Reference Section) and telephone calls to Suzanne Coffey (Sport, Recreation, & Active Living Branch, M.C. & H.) and former Head Coaches, Art Gremley and Ed Skiffington and coach Roly McSorley and the reports from the 1989 and 1993 Games Teams, as well as Dominion Command, Royal Canadian Legion along with other coaches and volunteers in the Legion Program, what is presented here is as complete as possible.
