



2026 Staff Call for Applications

Athletics New Brunswick is now seeking applicants for the upcoming provincial team programs. Applicants are asked to submit their coaching application and the requested documents to anb@anb.ca by Sunday April 5th, 2026.

Required documentation by applicants:

- Cover Letter – specific to position of interest
- Resume – Coaching and Athletics experience
- NCCP Coaching Transcript
- 3 References - relevant to sport setting and coaching/managing experiences

Coaches interested in multiple positions should be sure to note accordingly in the cover letter of their application

Canada Summer Games 2029: (2 positions)

1. Head Coach for the 2029 Canada Summer Games that will be held in Saint John – Moncton, NB.
2. Team Manager for the 2029 Canada Summer Games that will be held in Saint John - Moncton, NB

The dates of the Games are July 27th to August 12th, 2029 and it is understood that athletics will be a second week sport, encompassing the dates of August 5th-12th.



Jeux de la Francophonie 2027: (1 Position)

1. Head Coach for 2027 Jeux de la Francophonie that will be held in Yerevan, AM from July 23rd to August 1st, 2027

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE APRIL 5TH, 2026

The coach selection committee will be made up of no less than 3 individuals (who are not in conflict of interest) plus a chair that will be overseeing the selection process. Final selections for 2027 JDLF & 2029 CSG will be brought to the ANB board for ratification. The selection committee reserves the right to withhold the naming of all positions during this initial call.

Although ANB appreciates all applicants for our 2027 JDLF & 2029 CSG programs. Only individuals selected for an interview will be contacted about the 2nd phase of selection.

- Head Coach candidates must be Performance Coach certified.
- Head Coach applicants must have completed MED evaluation and Safe Sport Training
- Head Coach applicants must be ANB Coach Members in good standing
- Strong organizational skills
- National or Provincial Coaching/Managing Experience considered and asset
- Demonstrated background of strong leadership
