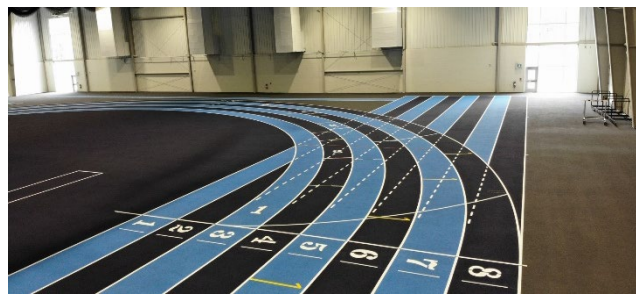




Coach & Technical Director

Saint John Red's Track & Field Club is seeking an experienced and energetic Coach and Technical Director to help support and grow our programming. This full-time position will be in Saint John using the Irving Oil Field House and Canada Games Stadium as your base.



Reds Track & Field is a united partnership of Saint John, Fredericton and UNB based programs focused on "one-team – two communities/campuses". We offer club programming and support the UNB REDS men's and women's Track & Field/Cross Country teams. Our goals are to be leaders in athlete excellence, growing our sport and being one of the top training centers in the Atlantic region.

As a Coach, you will contribute to the culture of high-performance sport within the club by directly coaching club athletes and members of the UNB Reds teams. As a Technical Director, you will support the development and delivery of club programs in Southern New Brunswick. Evening and weekend work is required as well as some provincial and national travel. This position reports to the President of Saint John Reds Track & Field Club:

Key roles and responsibilities of the position include: The position of Coach/Technical Director will fulfill two roles.

- a) Coach – For athletes in the club and UNB
 - Support the development of athletes age U20 and down.
 - Recruit, attract and support competitive athletes.
 - Provide clinics, competitions, development opportunities for athletes.
 - Act as an Assistant Coach to support the growth and success of the UNB Reds Track & Field teams.
- b) Club Technical Director – Support club programs and grow athletics within the Fundy Region.
 - Assist with the design, development, and delivery of club training programs.
 - Act as a resource person for coaches, athletes, officials, and volunteers
 - Support and develop volunteer coaches in clubs and schools.
 - Assist with all event hosting.

Qualifications

 - University Degree / Community College Certificate
 - Coaching Certification of or be working towards NCCP Performance Coach Certification
- Experience:
 - 3-5 years of experience in the direct coaching of athletes at a provincial level or higher.
 - Held coaching positions on provincial or national teams.
 - Experience with or understanding of the Canadian Inter-University Sports system (U-Sports).
 - Demonstrated coaching experience at the club and high school level.
 - Experience with field events, Combined-events and Para-athletes would be valuable.
 - Excellent communication skills and the ability to work in a team environment.
